THIS is the main fundraising event for the Hemlockstone Lions Club, with the proceeds going to many charities and good causes, including helping local students, disadvantaged children, inspiring 2012 sports people and helping the unwell people of the district.

The carnival is normally attended by up to 4,000 people. It is started by a

parade of floats through Stapleford, which set off from Bessell Lane (next to the railway sidings) and finish at the carnival site on Ilkeston Road Recreation Ground. Floats wanting to take part in the parade need to register with the organisers.

Space for a stall can be booked at a cost of £10 for a charity, commercial £15. On the day, stalls must be set up

by 11am as no vehicles will be allowed on the carnival site after that time.

The carnival field will be open to the public from 12 noon and officially opened at 1.30pm. It is expected to finish around 5pm.
